Report Overview

General Description and Significance

This report informs districts about students who are handicapped but have left the special education milieu because of a determination that they are not now disabled or because they graduated or because of other withdrawal reasons.

This report is used to provide information about the ages, reasons, and numbers of students who are no longer being educated as special education students by that district at the time of year-end reporting.

This report presents a picture of students who have exited special education during the current school year. There are two sections of the report. The first section displays the data in columns of exiting categories, called the “**BASIS OF EXIT**” and in rows by age; there are age subtotals for the 3-13, 14-21, and over 21 age groups. The second section displays the data in columns of racial/ethnicity groups and in rows of BASIS OF EXIT category. The final page of the report totals the student counts using the same format as the second section of the report.

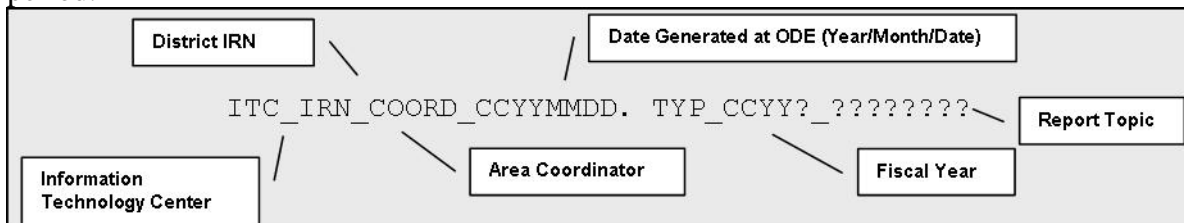

- Report field names are written in **BOLD SMALL CAPITAL LETTERS**.
- Options (values) for each data element are indicated in *ITALICIZED CAPITAL LETTERS* and are enclosed in quotation marks.
- Record names are displayed in *italicized bold letters*.
- File names are displayed in **CAPITALIZED BOLD LETTERS**.
- CCYYP denotes the century and year and processing period.

ODE Processing

Process Description

These data come to ODE in the *YAAT (Year End Attendance)* file based on original data from the district's *GI (Student Demographic)* and *GK (Student Attendance)* files. The aggregation process accumulates counts from data submitted during each week of the year-end reporting cycle. After the data are accepted and incorporated into its *Year End Attend RMS* files, the report is generated.

The *ACGR* file is used for completer information: diploma date, type of degree.

Data Source

The primary source of these data is the *Year End Attend RMS* file which is derived from *GI (Student Demographic)* and *GK (Student Attendance)* records. *ACGR* records are also used for completer counts.

The *Proficiency Detail* and *OGT Detail* are used to determined counts in category C, "Graduated, Met Alternate Requirements".

OEDS is used to provide header information for the report pages and to determine the output file name.

Report Sample, *Standard report*

Header Information

The first area of the header describes information about the report generation. The upper left section names the program from which the report was generated and the data source. The middle information identifies the producer of the report and the report title. The upper right section states the date on which the report was generated, the page number, and the reporting period to which the report belongs.

The second area of the header pertains to the recipient of the report. It identifies the district for which the report was produced, its IRN and COUNTY, the ITC and AREA COORDINATOR of the district.

Each page lists a separate handicapped condition and that condition is listed at the top of each page. Throughout the age sections of the report, that heading is printed as “BASIS OF EXIT FOR DISABILITY CONDITION” followed by the condition code and its description.

The disability heading is followed by column headers that indicate the data described on each detail line. On the age sections for the report, these are the letters “A” through “H”, representing a category of withdrawal codes explained at the bottom of each page. On the far right is the total column, “I”.

Throughout the race sections of the report, the handicapped condition heading is printed as “FOR DISABILITY CONDITION” followed by the condition code and its description. Each page, containing a single disability condition, has two age sections: the upper section includes students ages 3-13 while the lower section includes students ages 14-21. Each column header contains the description of the ethnicity codes used in EMIS. These are followed by a “NOT REPORTED” column and a “TOTAL” column on the far right.

Detail Information

The age section of the report divides student ages into three sections, 3-13 and 14-21 and 22 and over. Students are counted in

- Column A had a PRIOR DISABILITY but currently have none (code = “**”)
- Column B graduated with a diploma (DIPLOMA TYPE = “1” or “2”)
- Column C graduated through alternate assessments or passing standard was not required of this student
- Column D withdrew because of age (over 18, WITHDRAWAL REASON = “73”)
- Column E died
- Column F moved, known to be continuing, WITHDRAWAL REASON is listed under [BASIS OF EXIT](#)
- Column G moved, not known to be continuing, WITHDRAWAL REASON = “46” or “74”
- Column H dropped out, WITHDRAWAL REASON under [BASIS OF EXIT](#)
- Column I total of counts for this row in columns “A” through “H”

There is no page at the end of the age section that lists the total age counts by disability.

The race section of the report divides students into the two age sections, each denoted by its own heading and dashes above the ethnicity counts. The upper section reports counts for students aged 3-13. The lower section reports counts for students aged 14-21.

Each row contains a letter and description that represents one of the [BASIS of EXIT](#) categories. The columns contain counts for each of the six EMIS RACIAL/ETHNIC GROUP element codes

After each handicap condition page is printed for the race counts, there is a total page. It shows the counts of students in each of the age categories by the BASIS of EXIT category and by the racial/ethnic group.

Report Sample, CSV file

CSV File Format, General Information

This Comma Separated Value (CSV) format file contains records for each district that reported records.

In basic terms, the CSV file will contain the data element values separated by a comma to denote the end of one data element value and the start of a new one. For example, if you were to take the district IRN, its name, and county and convert it into a CSV file it would look like this:

012345, My District, Franklin

When imported into Excel, this string of comma separated values would be split into corresponding columns:

District IRN	District Name	County Name
012345	My District	Franklin

TIP: When importing data from a CSV file containing a numerical value that starts with a zero, like an IRN, it is important to import that type of data element as text and not a number in Excel. If imported as a numerical value, any leading zeroes will be removed.

Header Information

There is a header row with a column name for each field in the detail row. These names are separated by commas and are:

D-IRN, DISTRICT-NAME, NO-LNGR-RECVS, GRAD-HS-DIPL, RECD-CERTIF,MAX-AGE, DIED, MOVED-CONT, MOVED-NOT-CONT, DROPPED-OUT.

Detail Information

Error Detection and Correction

If a district finds a discrepancy between the report counts and those they anticipated, they can check their data for:

- The number of students who have disability codes
- The number of those students who have withdrawal codes and the values of those codes.
- The number of students who do not have a 01-15 disability condition but have a 01-15 prior disability condition
- The student dates of birth, used in the age calculations
- The ethnicity of the student
- The Proficiency or Ohio Graduation Test records for students who have met graduation requirements: required for graduation flags and test types
