- **RECOMMENDATION 1:** Creation of an Office of Computer Science Education (OCSE)
  - Recommendation 1a: Ohio should start with the industry when identifying CS education goals
  - o Recommendation 1b: Individual District Support to Implement Curriculum and Courses
- **RECOMMENDATION 2:** Establish CS as an Ohio Graduation Requirement by 2030
