

2003 Library Guidelines

The 2003 Library Guidelines represent a standards-based education (SBE) approach to school library programs. The project includes three parts:

- The Library Guidelines which define what students should know and be able to do as a result of an effective school library media program, and identifies conditions necessary to establish quality library programs;
- The Library Toolkit which provides the evidenced-based research that supports the Library Guidelines, and practical examples for implementing the Library Guidelines; and
- The Alignment Guide which aligns the Library Guidelines with Ohio's Learning Standards.
