Printing Invoices from Microsoft Internet Explorer®

To print an invoice from Microsoft Internet Explorer:

- 1. Click the drop down arrow next to the Select a format field.
- 2. Select Acrobat (PDF) file from the drop down menu.

Printing an Invoice from Mozilla Firefox

Printing Invoices from a Google Chrome Browser

To print an invoice from a Google Chrome browser:

- 1. Click the drop down arrow next to the **Select a format** field.
- 2. Select **Acrobat (PDF) file** from the drop down menu.
- 3. Click the blue **Export** link. Google Chrome displays options for the PDF file at the bottom of the browser screen.

- 4. Click the drop down arrow next to the FDP Invoice(1).pdf option. Note: If there is no FDP Invoice(1).pdf option, click the Keep button next to the message, "This type of file can harm your computer. Do you want to keep FDP Invoice.pdf anyway?" Adobe displays the FDP Invoice(1).pdf option for you to click.
- 5. Click the **Open** option. Google Chrome displays the Downloads page.
