CLEVELAND SCHOLARSHIP

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students residing in Cleveland Municipal School District (CMSD)
- Students entering any grades K-12
- NOTE: Students meeting these eligibility requirements are not eligible for EdChoice

REQUIREMENTS TO RENEW:

- Continue residing in CMSD
- Complete required assessments

CLEVELAND SCHOLARSHIP

Recent Changes

- Starting in the 2023-2024 school year, chartered nonpublic schools anywhere in the state are eligible to become Cleveland Scholarship providers.
- The value of the scholarship is tied to the school district base cost; the scholarship amount changes when the base cost changes



EDCHOICE-TRADITIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students assigned to a designated building based on residency
- Students meeting sibling criteria
- Students meeting foster or kinship care criteria

REQUIREMENTS TO RENEW:

- If meeting designated building criteria, reside in same district or move where assigned to another designated building
- Complete required assessments
- No more than 20 unexcused absences

EDCHOICE-EXPANSION SCHOLARSHIPS

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- New student applicants must have family income verified
- Award amounts based on family federal poverty level (FPL)

REQUIREMENTS TO RENEW

- Complete required assessments
- No more than 20 unexcused absences.

IMPORTANT: EDCHOICE SCHOLARSHIP

Income: The scholarship application <u>MUST</u> be completed **and submitted by** the school <u>before</u> the income verification is **submitted** by the parent. Please communicate this to your families.



This allows the income to link automatically to the scholarship application.



RECENT CHANGES FOR EDCHOICE PROGRAMS

STARTING IN THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR: STARTING IN THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR: Families eligible for both EdChoice-Traditional and Award amounts more specific based on family EdChoice-Expansion may choose their program income (previously required to choose Traditional) Income Affidavit available to families with no All families residing in Ohio are eligible for some income of any kind amount of the Expansion Scholarship Fewer Traditional program criteria Income Affidavit available to families not required to file taxes Sibling criteria eliminated from Expansion



STUDENT APPLICATION SUBMISSION

- All student applications are submitted by the school
 - 1. You must be a principal or a nominator (Link to directions for assigning roles in OEDS)
 - 2. All applications must have the following uploaded to the Docs tab:
 - Scanned application form
 - Birth Certificate
 - Proof of Address
 - 3. Many also require custody documents



STUDENT APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Best Practices for Submitting Student Applications:

- →Information in system
- →Proof of Address
- →Proof of Custody



INFORMATION IN SYSTEM

Student Tab:

- Information must match birth certificate
- Information that does not match may delay review completion and the SSID process
- Student middle names do not always save. Always verify the student tab is accurate and add the middle name if necessary (uncheck box)

Application Tab:

■ In Traditional, when qualifying based on assigned building, confirm district and school with the <u>School Assignment Area Tool for Designated Schools</u>

*Middle Name



Student has no middle name

PROOF OF ADDRESS REMINDERS



Must contain both billing and service addresses

A utility bill typically includes both



Documents that do not include both the billing and service addresses are not accepted



If submitting a mortgage or lease statement, it must be accompanied by a piece of business mail



PROOF OF CUSTODY

- Under Ohio law, custody defaults to the birth mother
- If a father applies without listing the birth mother as residing in the household, documentation of custody is required
- Fathers and other guardians may supply:
 - Court documents signed by a judge or magistrate naming them as the residential parent for school purposes OR
 - 2024-2025 Affidavit of Eligibility for a Traditional EdChoice Scholarship
 - May only be used in EdChoice-Traditional
 - Fathers may select option "D"
