



### Sponsoring Organizations of Ohio Family Day Care Homes Child and Adult Care Food Program

The Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) is a U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) program that provides healthy meals and snacks to children in day care. It provides reimbursement to participating day care home providers and child care centers for meals and snacks served to enrolled children. The Ohio Department of Education and Workforce administers CACFP throughout the state.

In Ohio, the following organizations administer the Family Day Care Home Program as part of the Child and Adult Care Food Program. All sponsoring organizations must follow the same USDA rules and regulations and provide the same reimbursement to providers. Providers must sign an agreement with a sponsoring organization to participate in the CACFP.
