Pupil Support includes: librarians, counselors, and nurses

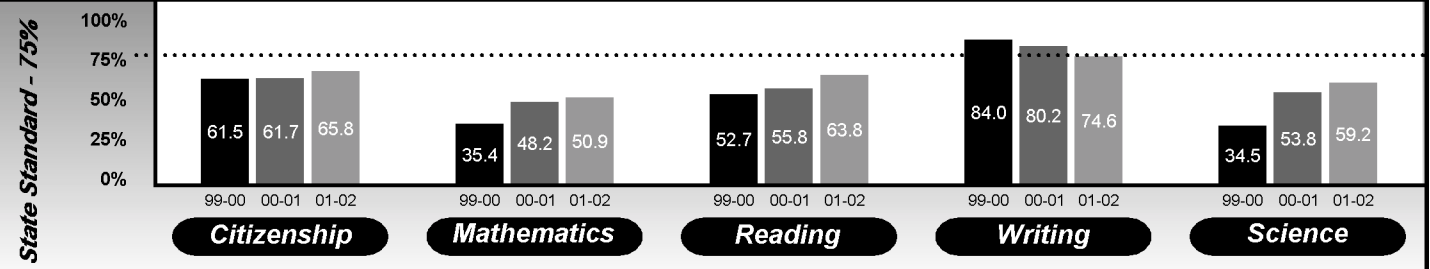
Staff Support includes: teacher training and college courses

Private Funds includes: foundation grants and corporate donations

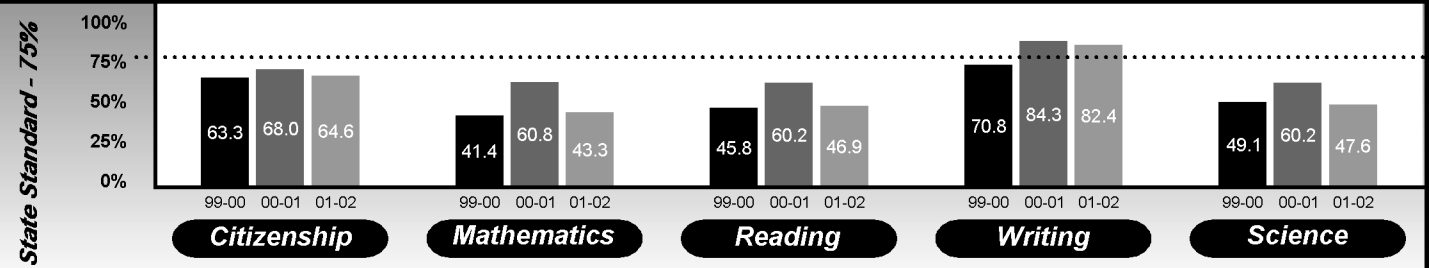

YOUR DISTRICT'S ASSESSMENT RESULTS OVER TIME

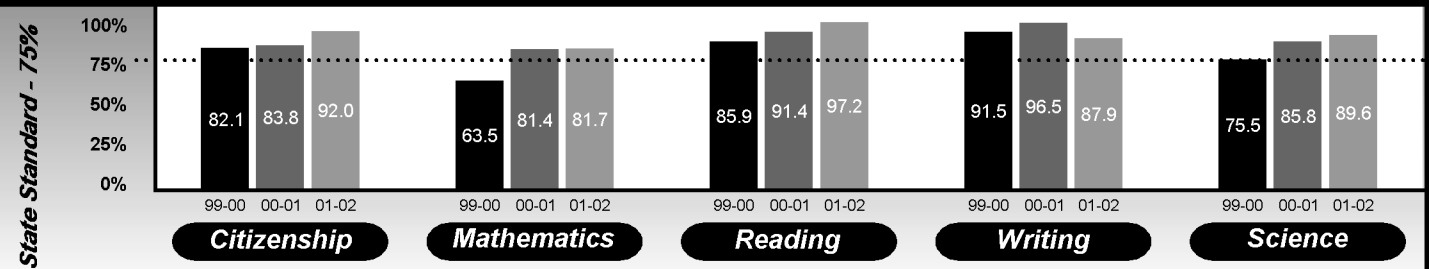
4TH GRADE PROFICIENCY



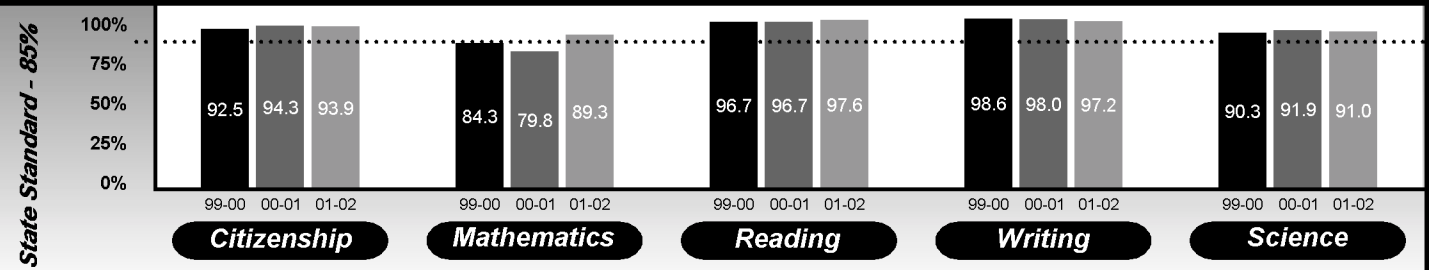
6TH GRADE PROFICIENCY
